For artillery units, there will be a \$100 powder bounty provided for the first four Confederate guns registered and the first four Union guns registered.

Please remind everyone attending that the encampment will be closed to all unauthorized vehicles after 7:30am on Saturday and will not reopen until after the conclusion of the battle on Sunday. Any unauthorized vehicles found in camp during this period will be towed at the owner's expense. We are sorry to have to institute this rule but in the past years, we have had a growing problem of vehicles in camp during spectator hours.
