The Washington County Historical Society would like to extend an invitation for you and your unit to attend the 22nd Annual Battle of Plymouth Living History Weekend. Camp and fight on the banks of the Roanoke River in the Historic District where the actual battle took place. We are extremely grateful for your support in past years and hope you will be able to join us for 148th anniversary event which will be held **April 27-29, 2012**. Activities shall include a Saturday Skirmish, the Torchlight Tour, the Fall of Fort Compher on Sunday afternoon and other events to be announced. Registration this year will be \$10 per person if registered by April 13th and \$12 per person if postmarked after April 13th. Registrations can be e-mailed to trudyr@plymouthnc.com. The usual amenities provided will include firewood, wheat straw and a meal Saturday evening (1 ticket per paid person registered).

For artillery units, there will be a \$125 powder bounty provided for the first four Confederate guns registered and the first four Union guns registered.

In 2010 we started a new tradition with the introduction of the Field of Honor to recognize those, on both sides, who made the ultimate sacrifice. Last year the scene was moved to the grounds of the Roanoke River Lighthouse and was included in the Torchlight Tour. This event continues to grow and we hope to have 2500 luminaries by 2014.
